Advisory Meeting Minutes- August 2022 Approved

Fiscal Reports & Expenditures- Lindsay Altizer

- DFC Expenses- Carryover of \$34,000 largely because this was a 9-month grant period. Expenditures for the Red Ribbon Week, banners for schools and community, pom poms and other giveaways.
- Partnership Acct. –\$. \$25,692.32 We received 2,100 in donations from various community groups in support of Red Ribbon Week activities. Among the donors, Kiwanis, Rotary, Maryhaven, Nationwide Children’s Hospital, Liberty Bank, Richwood Bank, Memorial Health, URE, Union County Foundation, Impact60, McCarthy and Cox, Wings, and Marysville Business Assoc. We earned \$1.28 in interest for Sept.
Richwood Coffee Donations= 196.00 from Sept.

Updates

Presentation by Nick Holcman from Maryhaven on Trauma Informed Care.

Nick Holcman (he/him), BSW and MSW from Michigan State. Nick is a crisis therapist with Maryhaven. Nick has 15 years of experience with LGBTQ advocacy and policy work. His’s preferred populations are SPMI and AOD. When Nick’s not working, he likes to kayak and hike

Nick shared background information regarding trauma and its effects on young people.

He went over the three E’s of Trauma- Events- actual or extreme threat of physical or psychological harm, or severe neglect of a child that hinders development. Experience- Helps determine whether it is a traumatic event, how and individual assigns meaning to the event. And Effects- Long lasting adverse effects of the event. HE then went through the six guiding principles of Trauma-Informed Care: Safety, Trustworthiness and transparency, Peer Support, Collaboration and Mutuality, Empowerment, Voice and Choice, and Cultural, Historical and Gender Issues.

Nick did point out that according to the 2019-20 OHYES! Data That Union County has at least 690 Trans Gender Non-Conforming students and at least 1,709 self-identifying LGBTQ students. These students are vulnerable to trauma experiences.

We Moved into the Adverse Childhood Event data, which showed that individuals who experience adverse events are more likely to have negative experiences later in life, substance use disorders,

suicide attempts, increased number of sexual partners, obesity, shorter lifespan, increased likelihood of chronic or autoimmune diseases.

Union County ACE data shows that 13.1% of students had an ACE score of 4 or higher. Compared to data from the Midwest region, Union County students are 8.9% more likely to have an ACE score over 4. Meaning that our children are more likely to be exposed to adverse events than others in the midwestern states. Nick then shared a range of parenting tools and other resources to help families.
